



Orlando at Christmas- Ballet and Cirque

The Orlando Ballet performs *The Nutcracker*, Friday, December 11th, at Bob Carr Performing Arts Center. The Orlando Ballet was founded in 1974 and has grown to become Central Florida's only professional, resident ballet company. It is one of the few ballet companies of its size and budget that is performing full-length, classical ballets. It is an impressive company of professional dancers that will perform the holiday traditional *Nutcracker*, written by Peter Tchaikovsky and produced by Robert Joffrey. Performances run from the 11th through December 20th.
