The Halifax Arts Festival is celebrating its 47th Anniversary this year. It is the second oldest art festival in the state of Florida and attracts a whooping 25,000 visitors each year. Over 250 artists are featured from all over the country. This amazing festival offers guests live entertainment, art competitions, children’s activities, and dining from many local restaurants. The festival begins on November 6th running from 9:00 a.m. and continues on November 7th running from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

The Turkey Rod Run is a sought out festival every year, attracting both locals and tourists. This event takes place every year on Thanksgiving weekend and is located at the Daytona International Speedway. The Turkey Run is one of the largest participant-based auto shows in the United States and combines a world-class swap meet and a 5000 plus custom car show all within one venue. General admission tickets are available beginning on November 26th and each show day following. You can purchase tickets at the speedway for \$10.00 - \$15.00. Children under the age of 11 are free.
