Outdoor activities in the Pigeon Forge area range from tubing and whitewater rafting to leaf peeping and wildlife-watching to horseback riding and helicopter tours. For extreme adventurers, try Zorb, the New Zealand thrill ride.

Pigeon Forge theaters offer family entertainment suitable for all ages. You can enjoy dinner theater, comedy shows, magic shows and live music, such as Gospel, country, bluegrass and old-fashioned rock 'n' roll.
