Dogwood Canyon Nature Park sprawls across the Missouri-Arkansas border, just south of Branson, MO. The entrance is located on Missouri Highway 86, approximately 16 miles west of U.S. Highway 65.

Many opportunities await you within this amazing 2,200-acre slice of Ozarks paradise. Choose from Self-guided Walking or Biking, Guided Tram Tours, Trout Fishing, and Horseback Riding. Or, select the Adventure Pass and spend the day with us. Enjoy lunch at the Outdoor Cafe and shop the general store for a great selection of gift and souvenir items. Make your visit even more special with a relaxing overnight stay in one of our private Log Cabins. The park is also a great place for memorable Group Events, such as customized tours with delicious streamside meals.

A spectacular outdoor experience awaits you at this nature park, which crosses the Arkansas and Missouri borders and features virtually untouched Ozark Mountain landscapes. The area offers walking trails, hiking trails, back country jeep tours, trout fishing, fly-fishing guides and clinics, horseback

riding, and tram tours. A gift shop is on site and group tours and cattle drives are available.

Dogwood Canyon is accessible to our guests with disabilities.

Aside from a few amenities to make Dogwood Canyon Nature Park more accessible to our guests, the rugged landscape has been left untouched and, with just a little imagination, you can travel backward to a time when European settlers first entered the area or, even further, to explore the mark that native Americans left on these Missouri hills and hollows.

It was his dedication to conserving our natural environment that has become the cornerstone for development of this spectacular wilderness experience.
