The “official” description of this particular attraction doesn't reveal all about this terrific adventure. The owner and guide is one Captain Bill Daniel, who is a U.S. Coast Guard-licensed seaman, a conservationist and a river historian. There's no one better to take you and your family on a tour of Florida's pristine St. John's River. The tour includes marshlands and backwaters to give you an up-close and personal view of some of Florida's most famous wildlife. You will see everything from deer to alligators, osprey and bald eagles, otters and manatees (which seaman of old called mermaids).

The tour is captivating and you'll wish it were longer than the 90 minutes it takes. Many who have taken the tour have called it one of the best things they have done while in Orlando (including Disney, Gatorland and Universal).

Reviewers call Captain Bill knowledgeable, opinionated, experienced and confident – all great attributes in a backwater tour guide, spotting gators and getting close to them (literally feet away), in their truly natural habitat. This is one of those true experiences that transcends the commercial, automated and

sanitized attractions. Some have also said the tour's trip to the Indian Mound was worth the trip alone.
